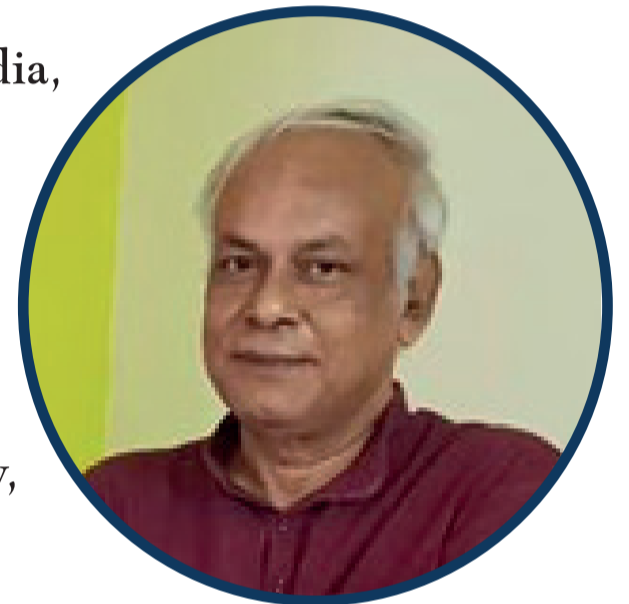
## Professor Barun Kanjilal

*Talk Title: Changing faces of Indian Healthcare Market:  
some recent evidences*

Professor Barun Kanjilal is an eminent health economist in India, currently an Independent consultant (Health economics & Financing) and Former Professor (Health Economics), IIMR University, Jaipur, India from where he retired in 2017 after working there for twenty-three years. He obtained MA in Economics from the University of Burdwan, West Bengal, India and Ph.D. in Economics from Louisiana State University, USA.



Before joining IIMR, he worked as a Reader in Economics in an undergraduate college under Calcutta University and as a post-doctoral fellow in the Department of Agricultural Economics at Louisiana State University.

His current area of interest is Development Economics with a strong focus on Health Economics and Financing and Health System Development. He has worked, as a Principal Investigator, on more than 50 research programs in India, related to public health financing and management.

Professor Kanjilal also holds a position of Senior Associate in the Department of International Health of the Bloomberg School of Public Health, Johns Hopkins University, USA. He has several publications to his credit which are primarily focused on inequity in health care and emerging issues in the health care market of India.

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
